1. Since the second defendant is not represented, let summons issue. Since the parties are siblings, the Court had suggested whether they would be open for exploring possibilities of mediation. Learned counsel for the plaintiff as well as the first defendant have submitted that their clients would be open to explore that possibility. However, before the matter is referred to the Mediation Centre, let notice issue to the second defendant.

2. Let an amended memo of parties consequently be filed by the plaintiff within a period of 48 hours. Steps for service upon the
