ORDER

29.01.2024

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1. Mr. Ramesh Singh, learned Senior Counsel for Atma Ram Trust submits that Atma Ram Trust has no objection to the payment of Rs. 19 Lakhs towards maintenance charges of the college, and the balance amount of Rs. 69 Lakhs ought to be paid by the Sanatan Dharam Sabha.
2. He further submits that since July, 2012, Governing Body of the college in question has members of only the Sanatan Dharam Sabha, as the members of Atma Ram Trust were ousted and were not re-appointed at the behest of University of Delhi. He submits that the said dispute is already a subject matter of another writ petition.
3. Upon hearing all the parties, this Court notes that as far as dispute in the present petition is concerned, the same pertains to the dues prior to July, 2012. Thus, it is clear that the payment which is due and payable towards



5% contribution of the Governing Body for maintenance of the college, has to be deposited by the Governing Body, which till the year 2012 consisted of both Atma Ram Trust and Sanatan Dharam Sabha.

4. Today, Mr. Biju Shankar, Advocate appears on behalf of Sanatan Dharam Sabha and submits that since documents are very old, he needs further time to file reply.

5. Let reply be filed within a period of four weeks. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within a period of two weeks thereafter.

6. In the meanwhile, both the Atma Ram Trust as well as the Sanatan Dharam Sabha shall endeavour to make the requisite payments as detailed aforesaid.
