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1. The dispute in the present appeal pertains to a partnership firm M/s National Iron Store in which both the appellant and the respondent, who are brothers, were partners.
2. Learned senior counsel for the appellant submits, on instructions, that insofar as the assets of the partnership firm M/s National Iron Store are concerned, the appellant has no objection to dividing the same in two equal parts and giving his share to the respondent. He, however, contends that the business which is now being carried out by the appellant is not in the name of the aforesaid partnership but in the name of M/s Abhishek Steel which is a sole proprietorship of the appellant. Though this averment that the business is being carried out solely in the name of M/s Abhishek Steel is vehemently denied by the learned counsel for the respondent, he has no objection to the parties exploring the possibility of an amicable settlement through mediation.
3. Accordingly, with the consent of the parties, the matter is referred to



the Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre. The parties/their authorised representatives will appear before the Mediation Centre on 26.07.2022.

4. List before the Court on 12.12.2022.
5. In the meanwhile, the parties will abide by the statement made before this Court on 12.11.2021.
