The two daughters namely Ms. Manvi & Ms. Vanshika also states that they would like to develop a good loving bond with their mother, which has not happened over the years since the appellant has remained separated and visitation rights also could not

3. Mr. Jauhar has pointed out that after four years of filing the custody petition the same was withdrawn by the appellant since she could not carry on with the same.
4. Let Ms. Manvi and Ms. Vanshika remain in touch with and visit the residence of the appellant according to their mutual convenience and spend time with the appellant.
