1. After some hearing, it is agreed that another copy of the quashing petition that is to be filed in terms of the settlement agreement shall be provided to learned counsel for the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner shall finalise the same and handover the duly signed copy (signed by the petitioner) to the respondent within a period of four weeks from today.
2. The quashing petition shall thereafter be filed as contemplated in the settlement agreement and a sum of Rs. 9,00,000/- shall be paid by the respondent at the time of necessary orders being passed thereon. Let the aforesaid exercise be concluded within a period of eight weeks from today.
3. Learned counsel for the respondent shall take instructions regarding:
 - i. return of silver articles of the petitioner as referred to in Paragraph-13 of the order dated 25.10.2023 in HMA No. 2102/2023 passed by the Principal Judge, Family Court, North, Rohini Courts.
 - ii. the amount to be paid towards meeting the basic necessities of the



parties' daughter (as averred in the affidavit filed along with the second motion petition). Let a copy of the said affidavit filed along with the second motion petition be also placed on record by the petitioner.
