1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.

CM APPL. 67029/2025 (Stay)

2. The present application under Section 151 of the CPC seeks the following prayers: -

“i. Pass an ad interim order staying the implementation/ execution proceedings before the Dy Labour Commissioner in respect of the Impugned Award or in the alternate stay the operation of the Impugned Award dated 27.01.2025 passed by the Ld. Presiding Officer, Industrial Tribunal & Labour Court in Sh. Naresh Kumar & Ors. vs. The Management of Municipal Corporation of Delhi bearing POIT No. 814 of 2016;

ii. Pass any other or further orders as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit.”

3. On the petitioner depositing a sum of Rs. 1,00,00,000/- (Rupees One Crore Only), with the Worthy Registrar General of this Court, within a period of six weeks, the execution proceedings shall remain stayed till the next date



of hearing. In case the same is not deposited, the said execution proceedings shall continue in accordance with law.

4. List on 11.02.2026.

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5. In the meantime, both the parties shall place on record their respective calculations with respect to the recovery proceedings.

6. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents further submits that respondent no. 2 has since passed away and details of his legal heirs has been given to learned counsel for the petitioner, who seeks time to move an appropriate application.

7. Litigation expenses of Rs. 15,000/-, to be paid by the petitioner to the respondents, except for respondent no. 2.

8. List on 11.02.2026.

9. In the meantime, digitized copy of the trial Court record be requisitioned.

10. Order be uploaded on the website of this Court, *forthwith*.
