1. Reply on behalf of the plaintiff is yet to be filed. Let the same be now filed as a measure of final opportunity, within four weeks. No reply is to be filed on behalf of defendants no. 3 & 4.

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2. Written statement filed on behalf of defendant nos. 1 & 2 is on record but suffers from a minor delay of 32 days. The condonation of delay application is yet to be listed. However, on
