1. The plaint be registered as a suit. Summons be issued to the defendant by all permissible modes on filing of process fee. *Dasti* service of summons is also permitted.
2. The summons shall indicate that the written statements must be filed within thirty days from the date of receipt of the summons. The defendant shall also file affidavits of admission/denial of the documents filed by the plaintiff, failing which the written statements shall not be taken on record.
3. The plaintiff is at liberty to file replications thereto within fifteen days after filing of the written statements. The replications shall be accompanied by affidavits of admission/denial in respect of the documents filed by the defendant, failing which the replications shall not



be taken on record.

4. It is made clear that any unjustified denial of documents may lead to an order of costs against the concerned party.
5. Any party seeking inspection of documents may do so in accordance with the Delhi High Court (Original Side) Rules, 2018.
6. List before the Joint Registrar for marking of exhibits on 22.02.2023.
7. List before the Court on 30.01.2023.
