No Written Statement has been filed by the defendant no.1,5&6. Needless to say, Written Statement, if any filed by the defendant no.1,5&6 shall be made part of the record as per law.



It is stated by learned counsel for the defendant no.3&4 that he will file his Vakalatnama shortly and also seeks sometime to file Written Statement on behalf of defendant no.3&4.
