1. Allowed, subject to just exceptions.

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2. Issue notice to the respondents. Mr. Bindu K. Nair accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2.

3. Till the next date of hearing, proceedings initiated by respondent No.1 pursuant to show cause notice dated 13.12.2019 shall remain stayed.

4. I may indicate herein that a perusal of the impugned show cause notice dated 13.12.2019 would show that it emanates from the order dated 14.11.2019 passed by respondent No.2. This order has been assailed by the petitioner in another writ petition i.e. W.P.(C) No.12189/2019. In W.P.(C) No.12189/2019, *inter alia*, the order dated 25.11.2019 has been passed by

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me. I have, via the said order, issued the following directions:

“... 7. Under these circumstances, for the moment, the operation of the impugned order, insofar as it prevents the petitioner from accepting a new assignment as an Interim Resolution Professional (IRP) or Resolution Professional, is stayed.

8. This direction was required to be passed as despite the impugned order stating that the restraint qua the petitioner will kick in only if amounts mentioned therein were not paid, respondent no.1/IRBI refused to relent notwithstanding the aforementioned direction for deposit of monies in court.”

5. The said writ petition is coming up for hearing on 28.2.2020.
6. A counter affidavit be filed within four weeks from today. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed before the next date of hearing.
7. Accordingly, list the captioned matter on the same date i.e. 28.2.2020.
