1. This appeal arises out of a suit for possession, permanent and mandatory injunction in respect of immovable property, filed by respondent No. 1 against her son [respondent No. 2 herein] and daughter-in-law [appellant herein].

2. In the course of hearing, learned counsel for the parties submit that the parties are willing to make an effort to resolve their disputes in mediation. I am informed that several proceedings have been filed by the parties against each other, including matrimonial proceedings between the appellant and respondent No. 2.

3. The parties are referred to mediation under the aegis of Samadhan, Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre, Shershah Road, New Delhi-110503. They are directed to appear before the learned



Mediator on 16.12.2024. The learned Mediator is requested to furnish a report to the Court before the next date of hearing.

4. In the event the mediation proceedings are unsuccessful, learned counsel for the parties are also requested to assist the Court on the next date of hearing with regard to the effect of Section 7 and 8 of the Family Courts Act, 1984, bearing in mind that the present suit was filed before the Civil Court and not the Family Court.

5. In the meanwhile, the Registry is also directed to summon the Trial Court record in electronic form.

6. Written submissions may also be filed by the parties within eight weeks from today.
