CM APPL. 50848/2026 (Joint application seeking disposal of the case in terms of settlement) & FAO 261/2024

1. By way of the present joint application, the parties seek disposal of the present appeal in terms of the settlement arrived at between the parties.
2. Learned counsels appearing for the parties submit that *vide* Memorandum of Family Settlement dated 29.07.2026, the parties have been able to arrive at an amicable settlement. It is further submitted, that later on, the parties also approached *Samadhan*, Delhi High Court Mediation & Conciliation Centre and the terms of family settlement were reduced into writing *vide* an Agreement dated 30.07.2026.

5. The Agreement as well as statements made today are taken on record and the parties are directed to remain bound by the terms of the settlement arrived at between them.

6. In view of the aforesaid, the appeal along with pending applications is disposed of.
