I.A. 24580/2023 (for exemption)

The application for exemption is allowed, subject to the plaintiff granting inspection of the documents filed, as and when required to do so, or filing the original documents at the stage of admission/denial.

The application stands disposed of.

I.A. & 26227/2023 (additional documents) & I.A. 26228/2023 (amendment of plaint)

1. These applications have been filed by the plaintiff to place on record additional documents and for permission to amend the plaint.
2. Summons have not yet been issued in the suit at this stage. Having regard to the fact that these applications have been made at a preliminary stage of the proceedings, these applications are allowed. The amended plaint is taken on record. The Registry is directed to place the amended plaint in the pleadings folder of the Court record and the additional



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documents in the folder of plaintiff's documents.

CS(OS) 813/2023

1. The amended plaint be registered as a suit. Issue summons to the defendants. Mr. D.P. Singh, learned counsel, enters appearance on behalf of the defendants and waives formal notice of summons.
2. Written statements be filed by the defendants within thirty days from today. The defendants shall also file affidavit of admission/denial of the documents filed by the plaintiff, failing which the written statement shall not be taken on record.
3. The plaintiff is at liberty to file replication thereto within fifteen days after filing of the written statement. The replication shall be accompanied by affidavit of admission/denial in respect of the documents filed by the defendants, failing which the replication shall not be taken on record.
4. It is made clear that any unjustified denial of documents may lead to an order of costs against the concerned party.
5. Any party seeking inspection of documents may do so in accordance with the Delhi High Court (Original Side) Rules, 2018.
6. List before the Joint Registrar for completion of service and pleadings, marking of exhibits and admission/denial of documents on 04.03.2024.
7. List before the Court on 09.05.2024.

I.A. 24579/2023 (ad-interim injunction)

1. Issue notice. Mr. D.P. Singh, learned counsel, accepts notice on behalf of the defendants.
2. Reply be filed within four weeks. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed



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within two weeks thereafter.

3. List before the Joint Registrar for completion of service and pleadings on 04.03.2024.

4. List before the Court on 09.05.2024.
