I.A. 17957/2025 (exemption from filing original/certified/typed copies etc.)

1. Allowed, subject to the plaintiff filing legible copies of documents within four (4) weeks from today.
2. The application stands disposed of.

I.A. 17958/2025 (u/S 80 (2), CPC)

3. The present application has been filed on behalf of the plaintiff under Section 80(2) read with 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 ('CPC') seeking exemption from advance service to the defendants.
4. In view of the urgent relief sought, exemption is granted to the plaintiff from serving the requisite notices to the defendants under Section 80(2), CPC.
5. The application stands disposed of.

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6. Let the plaint be registered as a suit.
7. Issue summons.
8. Summons be issued to the defendants through all permissible modes. The summons shall state that the written statement shall be filed by the defendants within thirty (30) days from the date of the receipt of summons. Along with the written statement, the defendants shall also file an affidavit of admission/ denial of the documents of the plaintiff, without which the written statement shall not be taken on record.
9. Liberty is given to the plaintiff to file replication, if any, within thirty (30) days from the receipt of the written statement. Along with the replications filed by the plaintiff, affidavit of admission/ denial of the documents of the defendants be filed by the plaintiff.
10. The parties shall file all original documents in support of their respective claims along with their respective pleadings. In case parties are placing reliance on a document, which is not in their power and possession, its detail and source shall be mentioned in the list of reliance, which shall also be filed with the pleadings.
11. If any of the parties wish to seek inspection of any documents, the same shall be sought and given within the timelines.
12. List before the Joint Registrar on 23rd September, 2025, for completion of service and pleadings.
13. List before the Court on 16th December, 2025 for framing of issues.
