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1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.
2. The present petition under Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Sections 10, 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 seeks the following prayers:-

“1. Allow the present petition and initiate appropriate contempt proceedings against the respondent/Contemnor for wilful Non-compliance of the judgment passed by the Ld. Family Court, Patiala House Court, New Delhi dated 29.03.2023 r/w Settlement deed dated 05.09.2022 from Delhi Mediation Centre, Patiala House Court, New Delhi in Mediation No. 1942/2022;

2. Direct the Respondent to ensure compliance with the terms of the MOU, particularly with respect to visitation and video call rights of the petitioner with his minor son;

3. Pass any other order which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and necessary in the interest of Justice.”

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that vide



MOU dated 05.09.2022, the parties entered into a Settlement Agreement. It is submitted that in terms of clause 5.4, 5.5 and 5.6, it was agreed between the parties that if any one of them shifts abroad, then the visitation rights would be in terms of the aforesaid clauses. The Judgment of the second motion was passed on 29.03.2023 whereby the parties have undertaken to abide by the terms and conditions. It was pointed out by the Petitioner that the respondent alongwith the child is presently residing in the United Kingdom, and despite communications, was not abiding to the aforesaid terms.

4. On the petitioner taking necessary steps, issue notice to the respondent, through all permissible modes, including through electronic mail, if any, returnable for the next date of hearing.
