ORDER

1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner points out that *vide* order dated 28.02.2024 the petitioners have been asked to report back on duty however the wages for 4 months from November, 2023 to February, 2024 has still not been paid.
3. It is pointed out that as per order dated 28.09.2021, the status quo was with regard to the engagement of these workers was to continue till the industrial dispute is resolved. It is thus submitted that the petitioners had admittedly violated the aforesaid order.
4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent submits that the wages had to be paid through an outsource agency. It is further submitted that the bill has to be raised by the said agency and thereafter the same would be



cleared and the wages would be paid to the workers.

5. In view of the above, this Court deems appropriate that the concerned Officer, SDM, District Election Officer, District South West, Government of N.C.T. of Delhi, Old Terminal Tax Building, Kapashera, New Delhi, shall remain present in the Court on the next date of hearing.
