1. This is an Application filed on behalf of the Petitioner seeking interim stay.
2. Learned Counsel for the Respondents submits that in compliance of the order dated 26.07.2024 passed by this Court, he has filed minutes of the meeting. He further submits that so far as concerns the prayer for interim relief which is sought for by the Petitioner in the present Application, the same is beyond the prayers in the present Petition.
