Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the respondents are not agreeable to treat the petitioner's service between 30.04.2012 to 30.04.2017 as regular service and, therefore, she cannot be granted any benefit for the said period other than those already received by her.
2. In these circumstances, the matter has to be heard on merits.
3. List on 02.02.2023.
4. It is however made clear that if in the meanwhile, the petitioner approaches the respondent for release of her terminal dues the amount payable including the provident fund contributions made by her will be expeditiously released in her favour as per the calculations of the respondent. Needless to state, the receipt of any amount by the



petitioner towards her terminal dues would, be subject to the outcome of the present petition and would not amount to the petitioner waiving of her right to claim the reliefs sought in the present petition.
