The petitioner/husband is seeking initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent/wife for reneging on her undertaking given before the learned Principal Judge, Family Court, during the course of hearing of first motion petition for divorce by way of mutual consent bearing HMA No. 624/2021 dated 07.07.2021.

4. None appeared on behalf of the respondent/wife, despite sending advance notice.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that although he is ready and willing to relinquish the right, title and interest in the property as described in the agreement in favour of the respondent/wife, however, she is not coming forward for filing of the second motion petition for divorce by way of mutual consent. It is



further pointed out that after the first motion petition for divorce by mutual consent; she has filed a fresh divorce petition on various grounds under the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955. Learned counsel for the petitioner has also submitted that the respondent in a contumacious manner has also blocked the operation of the joint account of the parties after personal loan was availed by him to meet the expenses to be incurred on the marriage of their son.

6. Let notice of the present contempt petition be issued to the respondent/wife by all permissible modes including *via* approved courier as well.

7. Re-notify on 13.11.2024.
