ORDER

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17.03.2025

1. The present writ petition has been filed seeking directions to the respondents to defreeze the bank account of the petitioner maintained by him with the Axis Bank.
2. The learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that counter-affidavit has been filed by the respondent no.6/Axis Bank Ltd. wherein it has been stated that the bank has frozen the account on the request of Central Cyber Crime, Police Station Bengaluru.
3. Accordingly, he orally prays to implead SHO of Cyber Crime Police Station, Bengaluru as respondent no.7. On the oral request of the petitioner, SHO, Cyber Crime Police Station, Bengaluru is impleaded as respondent no.7.



4. An amended memo of parties be filed within a period of two weeks from today.
5. On petitioner taking steps, issue notice to the newly added respondent no.7 by all permissible modes, returnable on 16.05.2025.
