2. This application has been moved on behalf of the applicant/appellant seeking some time for depositing the entire decretal amount with the worthy Registrar General of this Court.

3. Learned counsel for the non-applicant/respondent/Decree Holder is present on advance notice.

4. In short, the learned counsel for the applicant/appellant has submitted that the applicant/appellant has been able to secure a sum of Rs. 15 lakhs for depositing of the same towards the decretal amount in the Court and it is requested that for now she may be allowed to deposit the Demand Draft of Rs. 15 lakhs with the worthy Registrar General of this Court, for now.
