1. Exemption allowed subject to just exceptions.
The application stands disposed of.

Crl. M.A.2525/2020 (delay in re-filing)

2. For the reasons stated in the application, delay in re-filing is condoned.
The application stands disposed of.

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3. The petitioner has challenged the impugned order dated 17.8.2019, by virtue of which, the petitioner has been directed to pay Rs.25,000/- as interim maintenance to the respondent and her child from the date of filing of the petition i.e 18.2.2019. Counsel for the

petitioner states that this order is without jurisdiction as petitioner and respondent no.1 are residents of Dehradun. He further submits that the petitioner had filed a petition of divorce in Dehradun courts, and thereafter, respondent filed a transfer petition before the Hon'ble Supreme which was dismissed.

4. Be that as it may, counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is ready to deposit the 50% of the arrears of the maintenance amount in the account of the petitioner within four weeks, and petitioner shall keep on paying the maintenance as granted by the Family Court. Subject to deposit of the 50% of the arrears of the maintenance amount, the proceedings before the trial court are stayed.

5. Issue notice to the respondents, by all modes, on the petitioner taking the necessary steps, returnable on 8.5.2020.
