1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.
2. The present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeks
the following prayers:

“A. Issue a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ order or direction in the nature of a writ directing the Respondent No.1 to immediately hold a meeting in terms of Rule 253 of the Rules pursuant to the requisition notices dated 26.03.2025 and 13.06.2025.

B. Issue a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ order of direction in the nature of writ directing the Respondent No. 2 to circulate the detailed list of business (agenda) with entire documentation to all Board Members at least fifteen days before



the said meeting, via e-mail as well as via physical copies;

C. Issue a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ order or direction in the nature of writ directing that the minutes of the said Board meeting should be recorded in detail by a member democratically nominated by all other Board members and must be verified and signed by all other Board members:

D. Issue a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ order or direction in the nature of writ directing the Respondents to ensure regular meetings of the Board take place, with list of business (meeting agenda) being shared well in advance in accordance with Rule 253 of the Rules;

E. Direct the Respondent to pay costs;

F. Pass any other order or direction as may be deemed fit.”

3. Learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner submits that during the pendency of the present petition, the Chairman had convened meeting on 18.08.2025 vide notice of the same date, which has been filed along with the application bearing CM APPL. 49512/2025 and points out that the said notice was accompanied by any agenda.

4. Issue notice.

5. Learned counsels for respondent nos. 1 and 2 accept notice and seek time to file response to the present petition. Let the same be done before the next date of hearing, with an advance copy to learned counsel for the petitioner.

6. Learned counsel for respondent no. 3 accepts notice. Response, if any, be filed before the next date of hearing.
