This appeal is against the impugned judgment dated 18.08.2018 whereby the suit for recovery of Rs.4,63,915/- filed by the respondent was decreed with interest at the rate of 13.5% per annum.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the appellant he never stood as a guarantor for the loan advanced to the defendant no.1/respondent no.2 and even the documents of guarantee neither bear his signatures nor his photograph. However the learned Trial Court held otherwise saying a perusal of the loan application and the guarantee agreement would show though it does not bear the photograph of the guarantor, but, this is of no consequence as it bear signatures of the guarantor/appellant herein.
