It is a petition u/S 482 Cr.PC for quashing of the summons u/S 132 & 135 of the Customs Act, 1962. Vide judgment dated 15.07.2009, the Hon'ble Court opined:



“In these circumstances, though the petitioner is entitled for quashing, but since the second respondent has approached the Supreme Court and the SLP filed by them is still pending, the matter is adjourned sine die awaiting further orders by the Apex Court with liberty to the parties to revive the present petition, if required.”

Therefore by the said finding, the matter was adjourned sine die and now that SLP/Civil Appeal has been disposed of by the Hon'ble Court vide order dated 04.09.2015.
