ORDER

I.A. 11332/2025 (u/O VII Rule 14(3), CPC)

1. This application is being filed on behalf of the plaintiffs under Order VII Rule 14 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, seeking to place additional documents on record.
2. The documents sought to be placed on record by way of the present application are detailed in paragraph 3 of the application, and the same are set out below:-

“3. *The Plaintiffs submit that, at the time of the filing of*



the suit, the. Plaintiffs were not having the certified copies of the following documents:

a. Compromise application under Order XXIII Rule 3 CPC 1908, filed in CS (OS) 2426/1996, titled as "Pramod Kumar Gupta versus Prakash Mittal & Others" before this Hon'ble Court, by the parties i.e., Praveen Kumar Gupta and Ors, along with order dated 01.08.2000, passed by this Hon'ble Court in abovementioned suit.

b. Six registered Wills of various dates in May 1996, executed by Late Sh. Jiwan Lal, with respect to distribution of his share in the subject property."

3. The first document, at serial no. (a), is a compromise application filed before this Court, which has resulted in a decree being passed on 1st August, 2000, by this Court.

3.1. Hence, there cannot be any objection to taking the aforesaid document on record.

4. As regards the other documents, these are stated to be six registered wills of various dates in May 1996, executed by the Late Sh. Jiwan Lal with respect to the distribution of shares in the subject property. The aforesaid documents find a mention in paragraph 5(h) of the plaint at PDF page 27.

5. Counsel for the plaintiffs submits that they could not obtain the certified copies of six registered wills, as some of the family members, in favour of whom the Wills were executed, have passed away, and as per the procedure, only the beneficiaries could apply for the certified copies.

6. In my view, the documents sought to be placed on record are relevant for the proper and effective adjudication of the suit. Subject to the objections of the defendants with regard to the genuineness and validity of the aforesaid documents, the same are permitted to be taken on record.



7. Accordingly, the present application is allowed and the aforesaid documents are permitted to be taken on record.

8. Let affidavit of admission/denial of the documents be filed within two weeks.

9. List before the Joint Registrar on 14th October, 2025.

10. List the suit along with pending applications for hearing on 10th December, 2025, at 4:00 PM.
