1. None appears for the petitioners when the matter is called out

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents no.1 to 5 submits that he does not wish to file any reply, since issue in the present matter is covered by judgements of Division Bench of this Court. He relies upon the case of ***Jai Bhagwan & Ors. vs. Union of India (UOI) & Ors., (2002) 63 DRJ 580 (DB)*** and judgment in the case of ***Umed Singh vs. GNCT Delhi, (1997) 69 DLT 957 (DB)***.
