1. As per office report, notice to the respondents could not be issued as PF was not filed.
2. It is observed that there is a delay of 1008 days in filing the captioned appeal.
3. On specific query of this Court, learned counsel appearing on behalf of appellant submitted that the PF could not be filed due to the error on his part. Thus, he prayed for issuance of fresh notice to the respondents.
4. Heard and perused the order dated 19th December, 2023, whereby, the Predecessor Bench of this Court had issued notice to the respondents, however, due to the negligence committed on the part of learned counsel for the appellant, PF could not be filed within stipulated time.

The receipt thereof shall be furnished before the Registry of this Court before the next date of hearing.
