1. Learned counsel for the plaintiff submits that PW-1 has been cross-examined on three dates after the last order and his cross-examination is still pending and learned counsels for the sole defendant as also the plaintiff in CS(OS) 621/2017 state that they would take two more dates each to cross-examine PW-1.
2. Today learned counsel for the defendant as also learned counsel for the plaintiff in CS(OS) 621/2017 state that together they would take approximately two more dates to cross-examine PW-1.
3. The cross-examination of PW-1 for two more dates is permitted before the learned Local Commissioner whereafter the evidence will be recorded by the learned Joint Registrar.
4. Application is accordingly disposed of.
