1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.

CM APPL. 48990/2025(Exemption)

2. Exemption allowed, subject to all just exceptions. The application stands disposed of.

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3. The present petition under Section 12 read with Section 2(b) of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Section 27(5) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 seeks the following prayers:-

- “a) Allow the present Contempt Petition;
- b) Direct the Respondents to furnish all the documents as directed in orders passed by the Ld. Arbitral Tribunal;
- c) Issue notice of Contempt of Courts against Respondents;
- d) Initiate proceedings for contempt of the Ld. Arbitral Tribunal against the Contemnors for their willful disobedience and prosecute them in accordance with Law;



e) Punish the Respondents in accordance with Section 12 r/w Section 2(b) of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 r/w Section 27(5) of Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996 for their willful disobedience and flagrant conduct, disobedience of Orders dated 19.04.2024 & 02.09.2024 passed by the Ld. Arbitral Tribunal in arbitration between “*Tata Capital Limited and M/s. Green Land Motors & Ors.*”

Pass such other and further orders as this Hon’ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the present case.”

4. *Vide* order No.27 passed on 28.05.2025, the learned Sole Arbitrator in IA No. 3 of 2024 passed the following order: -

“36. In view of the above, the Tribunal makes a reference to the High Court of Delhi in accordance with the provisions of Section 27(5) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 invoking its jurisdiction for taking appropriate action against the Respondent Nos. 1, 2 and 5 for deliberate and contumacious violation of the orders of this Tribunal dated 19.04.2024 and 02.09.2024.”

5. On the petitioner taking necessary steps, issue notice to the respondents through all permissible modes, returnable for the next date of hearing.
6. List alongwith CONT.CAS(C) 766/2023 on 09.10.2025.
7. In the meantime, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty to place on record additional documents. Let the same be done before the next date of hearing.
