1. This is an application filed by the respondent No.2(D) and 4(A), namely, Pradeep under Section 151 CPC for the release of the decretal amount to the extent of the security furnished by the surety/Amit Sharma in terms of order dated 08.12.2023 passed by the Hon'ble Court.

2. The Hon'ble Court vide order dated 08.12.2023 has, *inter alia*, passed the following orders:-

“C.M. APPL. 24368/2023

.....

2. By this application, applicants- respondent nos. 2D and 4A seek withdrawal of release of amount of Rs.13,19,360/- to the extent they have furnished security. The said amount is lying deposited with the Registrar General of this Court. Learned counsel for the appellant has no objection qua the prayer made in this application



3. The application is allowed and Registrar General is directed to release the aforesaid amount in favour of the applicants-respondent nos. 2D and 4A within a period of 4 weeks from today upon satisfaction of the fact of security.....

3. Perusal of the file reveals that earlier, Mr. Amit Sharma has stood as surety for the respondent Nos.2D/4A, namely, Pradeep. Verification report in respect of the property furnished as security by the said Mr. Amit Sharma/Surety has already been received from the concerned SDM as recorded in the order dated 14.12.2022.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the respondent Nos.2D/4A, namely, Pradeep, that said respondent and surety are not available today.

5. At request, renotify for appearance of the respondent No.2D/4A, namely, Pradeep and surety/Amit Sharma for the purposes of recording their respective statements on 09.02.2024.

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6. At this stage, it is submitted by learned counsel for the respondents that the Hon'ble Court vide order dated 08.12.2023 has also, *inter alia*, passed order qua release of the accrued interest amount to respondent Nos.2(a)/3(a), namely, Neelam and respondent Nos.2(c)/3(c), namely, Manju. As such, let Registrar (B&A) also file a report by the next date of hearing regarding the accrued interest lying deposited in the present in respect of the aforesaid respondents.
