1. The present application has been filed under Section 151 of Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 on behalf of Respondent No. 5/applicant namely Ram Mehar, seeking directions regarding release of the decretal amount of Rs. 47,74,855.95 along with interest accrued thereon.
2. It is stated that the amount is lying deposited in terms of the Order dated 01.05.2019.
3. Despite opportunity being granted, no reply has been filed on behalf of the non-applicants. In view of the above, the application is



allowed.

4. On Respondent No. 5 furnishing an indemnity bond to the extent of 50% of the decretal amount, providing adequate security of the remaining 50% balance amount to the satisfaction of the Registrar General of this Court and upon due verification of the Respondent No. 5/applicant's name and identity, the decretal amount of Rs. 47,74,855.95 along with interest accrued thereupon, if any, be released to the applicant/Respondent No. 5.

5. Let an undertaking in the form of an affidavit be filed by Respondent No. 5 setting out that in the event the appellant succeeds in the present appeal, Respondent No 5 shall refund the compensation so released to the Appellant.

6. List before the learned Registrar General on 25th August, 2025 for the aforesaid purpose.

7. The present application stands disposed of with the aforesaid directions.
