1. Exemption allowed, subject to all just exceptions.

3. Through the present application, the petitioners seek condonation of delay in re-filing CRL.REV.P. 309/2025.
4. Owing to sufficient cause being shown in the application, the same is allowed, and the delay of 48 days in re-filing the revision petition stands condoned.

8. Learned APP for State, who appears on advance notice, accepts notice and seeks some time to file status report/reply. Let the same be filed at least three days prior to the next date of hearing.

It is pointed out by learned counsel for the petitioners that in the prayer clause of the present petition, there is a typographical mistake as regards to the FIR number which is mentioned as FIR no. 05/2013 instead of FIR No. 05/2023. He seeks some time to file amended petition along with the amended prayer. Let the same be filed within two weeks from today.
10. In view of the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***Jagjeet Singh & Ors. vs. Ashish Mishra @ Monu & Anr., 2022 9 SCC 321***, the complainant/victim is entitled to be heard in the present proceedings. Accordingly, let intimation be sent by the Investigating Officer to the complainant/victim informing them that they are entitled to be heard in the present proceedings, for which they may remain present (either in-person or via videoconferencing) or be represented on the next date.
