1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.

CRL.M.(BAIL) 885/2026 (for suspension of sentence)

2. The present application has been filed by the Appellant under Section 430 read with section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita seeking suspension of sentence and release of the Appellant on bail during the pendency of the instant appeal.

3. Issue notice. Ld. APP for the State accepts notice and seeks time to file a reply/status report. Let the same be filed by the next date of hearing.

4. In the meantime, the latest Nominal Roll of the Appellant be requisitioned from the concerned Jail Superintendent.

5. *Vide* order on sentence dated 2nd June, 2025 passed by Id. ASJ, FTSC, POCSO-02, Dwarka Courts, New Delhi, certain compensation has been awarded to the victims in the following terms:



“[...]

21. Even though, the emotional harm cannot be quantified in terms of money, however, having considered the gravity of the above mentioned offences, the severity of emotional harm suffered by the victims, age of victims and losses suffered by them, the compensation for the mental injury, **the victims 'R' and 'N' are entitled to get Rs. 2 lakhs each. The victims are granted compensation of Rs. 10.5 lakhs (Rs. 7 lakhs plus 50% of 7 lakhs) each for offence of aggravated penetrative sexual assault/rape committed upon them.**

22. Amount, if any, disbursed to the victims 'R' and 'N', be set off from the final compensation amount...”

6. Issue notice to the Secretary, Delhi Legal Service Authority (hereinafter, ‘DLSA’), South West.
7. Let the DLSA file a status report as to the disbursement of the compensation.
8. List on 25th May, 2026.
9. Copy of this order to be communicated to the concerned Jail Superintendent for necessary information and compliance.
10. Copy of this order be communicated to Secretary, DSLSA, for necessary information and compliance.
