1. Perusal of the record reveals that, vide order dated 18.02.2026, the Hon'ble Court condoned the delay in filing the written statement on behalf of Defendant No. 3 and directed that the same be taken on record.
2. Till date, no replication to the written statement of Defendant No. 3 has been filed.

7. Accordingly, the plaintiff is directed to coordinate with the Registry and get the said tabulated chart placed on record.
