1. Petitioner was defending a claim before the Arbitral Tribunal.
2. Against the award eventually ordered by Learned Arbitral Tribunal, the claimant as well as non-claimant have filed separate petitions under Section 34 of *Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996*.
3. During the pendency of the abovesaid petitions, the original claimant expired and the grievance in the present petition is with respect to order dated 22.07.2025, whereby application filed under Order XXI Rule 3 CPC has been allowed and instead of his surviving legal representatives being brought on

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record, the beneficiaries under the alleged Will have been brought on record.

4. Learned counsel for respondent appears on advance notice and submits that the legal representatives of the deceased claimant have given no objection to such impleadment and, therefore, the present petition has no merit.
