ORDER

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1. Pursuant to previous order, both parties are present in Court. After some deliberations, parties have agreed to mediate without prejudice to their respective rights and contentions.
2. While the petitioner states that the settlement agreement has been executed with the consent of parties on 14th June 2024, the respondent states that she was coerced into the settlement and, thereafter, made a complaint to the referral forum i.e., the CAW Cell, for revival of the complaint.
3. As per the settlement agreement, an amount of Rs.7,00,000/- has been agreed upon for final settlement. The respondent appears to be demanding a higher amount.
4. Parties shall appear before the Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre on 2nd June 2025, at 3 P.M. A copy of the order to be sent accordingly to DHCMCC.



5. List before Court on 24th September, 2025.
6. In the meantime, if the parties are able to settle the matter, or the mediation is unsuccessful, they can approach the Court.
