W.P.(C) 262/2024

1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner alleging that his two-wheeler vehicle, registered vide registration No.DL 13S2191, was impounded by the respondent nos.2 and 3 from within the premises of the petitioner on 10.08.2023 and thereafter towed away by the licensed scrapper without following the due process of law.
2. It is submitted that the petitioner is desirous of taking the vehicle outside Delhi and for that purpose he has made a representation to the respondent for release of the vehicle.
3. Attention is drawn to order dated 22.08.2023, passed by this court in a batch of petitions whereby appropriate directions have been given for release



of vehicles in a similar context, subject to certain conditions as enumerated in the said order.

4. Issue notice.
5. Learned counsel, as aforesaid, appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondent nos.1 and 2.
6. Issue notice to the respondent no.3, on necessary steps being taken by the petitioner, through all permissible modes, including electronically.
7. Till the next date of hearing, the respondent no.3 shall not scrap the concerned vehicle, if not already scrapped. In case, the vehicle has been scrapped, the details/date of the same along with supporting documents shall be filed before the next date of hearing.
