1. Issue notices. Notices accepted by Id. Counsel for the plaintiff who presses for an opportunity to file a response. Let the replies be filed within four weeks, with an advance copy of the same to the opposite side. Rejoinder/s thereto, if any, be filed thereafter within two weeks of receiving an advance copy of the reply. Put up for completion of pleadings.

I.A. No. 20092/2025 on behalf of the plaintiff seeking discovery and production of the defendants documents under Order XI Rule 1 CPC.

2. Notice in the present IA was issued to defendant nos. 12, 14 & 15 only since defendant nos. 1 to 10 are John Doe whose details are to be furnished by these defendants.

3. Id. Counsel for defendant no. 12 submits that they have supplied the required information to Id. Counsel for the plaintiff and that they shall be filing a compliance affidavit within three weeks. Further, Id. Counsel submits that reply to the IA is in the process of being filed as per rules.

4. Id. Counsel for defendant no. 14 also submits that they have supplied the required information to Id. Counsel for the plaintiff. Compliance affidavit in this regard is already on record on behalf of defendant no. 14. Reply to the IA has been filed but is under objections. Id. Counsel is directed to remove the objections.

5. Id. Counsel for defendant no. 15 also submits that they have supplied the required information to Id. Counsel for the plaintiff. Compliance affidavit in this regard is already on record on behalf of defendant no. 15. Further, Id. Counsel submits that reply to the IA is in the process of being filed as per rules.



I.A. No. 20090/2025 on behalf of the plaintiff under Order XXXIX Rules 1 & 2 r/w Section 151 CPC seeking inter alia ex-parte ad-interim injunction against the defendants.

6. Ld. Counsels for defendant nos. 12 & 14 submit that they have complied with the directions of the Hon'ble Court regarding blocking / suspending the infringing listings. Ld. Counsels has further highlighted that apart from the directions given on 19.08.2025, plaintiff had further provided a dynamic workbook which is being continuously updated and accordingly defendant nos. 12 & 14 is to continuously issue directions regarding blocking and suspending the infringing listings, which is being done.

7. Ld. Counsel for defendant no. 12 submits that reply is in the process of being filed as per rules. Reply on behalf of defendant no. 14 is under objections.

8. Ld. Counsel for defendant no. 15 submits that directions passed by the Hon'ble Court regarding blocking and suspending the infringing listings have been complied with. Compliance affidavit in this regard has already been filed which also is for IA No. 20092/2025. Ld. Counsel further submits that if required, reply shall be filed as per rules. Put up again on the next date.

9. Summons have been accepted on behalf of defendant nos. 12, 14 and 15 on 19.08.2025. Amended memo has not been filed by the plaintiff.

10. PF has not been filed for issuance of summons to defendant nos. 1 to 11 & 16. Ld. Counsel for the plaintiff submits that steps are being taken to serve defendant nos. 1 to 11 and 16.



11. Written statement filed on behalf of defendant no. 14 is lying under objections. Ld. Counsel is directed to take steps to bring the same on record.
