I.A No. 31360/2025 on behalf of the defendant no. 12 for condonation of delay of 78 days in filing the written statement.

1. Issue notice. Notice accepted by Id. Counsel for the plaintiff. Id. Counsel for the plaintiff submits that he has no objection if the application is allowed.
2. For the reasons stated in the application and in view of the 'no objection' of Id. Counsel for the plaintiff, application is allowed. Delay stands condoned. Written statement of defendant no. 12 is taken on record. Replication be filed within the period permissible, as worked out from today. **IA stands disposed off.** Defendant no. 12 is directed to **re-file** the written statement within 5 days whereafter the Registry is directed to place the same on record.



I.A. No. 24140/2025 on behalf of defendant no. 14, Flipkart Internet Pvt. LLP seeking deletion from the array of parties.

3. None appeared on behalf of the applicant. No reply has been filed on behalf of the plaintiff. However, ld. Counsel for the plaintiff informs that defendant no. 14 has been exempted from appearance by the Hon'ble Court for the reason that its presence may be required at a later stage in the suit for directions. Since presence of defendant no. 14 might be required later in the suit proceedings, in view of the clear observations of the Hon'ble Court, the present IA is **dismissed** at this stage. **IA stands disposed off.**

I.A. No. 20092/2025 on behalf of the plaintiff seeking discovery and production of the defendants documents under Order XI Rule 1 CPC.

4. Defendant nos. 12, 14 and 15 have been exempted from further appearance. Reply on behalf of defendant no. 14 is on record. Reply on behalf of defendant nos. 12 & 15 has not been filed.

5. Ld. Counsel for the plaintiff submits that since the necessary information has been supplied to the plaintiff, present application is not being pressed further. Consequently, **IA stands disposed off.**

I.A. No. 20090/2025 on behalf of the plaintiff under Order XXXIX Rules 1 & 2 r/w Section 151 CPC seeking inter alia ex-parte ad-interim injunction against the defendants.

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6. Defendant nos. 12, 14, 15 and 16 have been exempted from further appearance.



7. Written statement of defendant no. 12 has been taken on record today. Replication be filed within the period permissible, as worked out from today.

8. Written statement of defendant no. 14 is on record. Replication thereto is in the process of being filed, as per rules. Defendant no. 13 has been **deleted**.

9. Ld. Counsel for the plaintiff submits that they have not been able to take steps to serve defendant nos. 1 to 10 for the reason that Registry is insisting on specific directions for issuance of summons to defendant nos. 1 to 10. In terms of the order dated 19.08.2025 passed by the Hon'ble Court, plaintiff has filed amended memo of parties containing serviceable details of defendant nos. 1 to 10. Consequently, on filing of PF within a week, summons be issued to defendant nos. 1 to 10 through speed post, email and courier.

10. Ld. Counsel for the plaintiff further submits that there is no objection to the deletion of defendant no. 11. Consequently, defendant no. 11 stands deleted. Amended memo of parties be filed since defendant no. 13 and defendant no. 11 have been deleted.

11. Put up for completion of pleadings on 25.03.2026.
