1. This is an Application filed on behalf of the Appellant seeking the following prayers:

“a) Permit the appellant to deal with her self-acquired properties as mentioned in para 3 hereinabove.”

3. Issue Notice.

3.1 Learned Counsel for the Respondent No.7 accepts notice and submits that she has not received a copy of the Application. Let the copy of the same be supplied to the learned Counsel for Respondent No.7 during the course of the day under acknowledgement.

4. Let notice of this Application be served upon the remaining Respondents through Counsel.

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6. Learned Counsel for the parties submit that the Trial Court Record in this Appeal is the same as in RFA 630/2022 which has already been requisitioned by the Court on 22.07.2024.



7. The present Appeal has been filed to set aside the Impugned Judgment and Preliminary Decree dated 06.02.2021 passed by the learned ADJ-02, Saket Courts, South District, New Delhi in Suit No. 3683/1991 [which was renumbered as 7937/2016].
8. The record shows that there are several pending Applications. Learned Counsel for the parties shall complete the pleadings in the pending Applications within the next three weeks.
9. Learned Counsel for the Appellant and Respondent No.7 shall jointly prepare a convenience compilation within three weeks and file the same on record.

11. List before Court on 28.08.2024 at 4 pm.
12. Learned Counsel for the parties seek and are granted time to file their respective written synopsis. Let a synopsis be filed, not exceeding three pages each, along with the compilation of judgments, if any, relied upon at least one week before the next date of hearing.
- 12.1 All judgments sought to be relied upon by the learned Counsel for the parties shall be filed with an index which also sets out the relevant paragraph numbers and the proposition of law that it sets forth.
