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1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.
2. Learned counsel for the MCD seeks further time to file the status report.
3. *Vide* order dated 06.03.2025, in W.P.(C) 16931/2024, the Hon'ble Division Bench of this Court, passed the following directions:

“11. Accordingly, we modify the order passed by the Tribunal by holding that the interest at the rate of 7.5% p.a. would be reckoned from the date of the petitioner's superannuation, and not from the expiry of three months from the order of the Tribunal, till the date when the principal amount of the retiral dues was/is paid. We clarify that the direction for increase in the rate of interest to 12% p.a., in the event the amount is not/has not been paid before the expiry of six months from the date of the judgement of the Tribunal, stands as it is.”

4. Let a compliance report be placed on record before the next date of



hearing. In case of non-compliance, the concerned Officer shall remain present before the Court on the next date of hearing.
