ORDER

05.04.2024

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1. Petitioner is present along with his counsel. He states that his total income in a month is about Rs.10,000/- as he only has a small grocery shop. It is also stated that he does not own any house and is living on rent close to the house where his parents reside and is paying a monthly rent of Rs.4,000/- per month. In support, copy of the rent agreement executed between one Satish and him is handed over and is taken on record. On repeated query by the Court, Petitioner is consistent that he owns no property and his monthly income has never exceeded Rs.10,000/-.

2. Learned counsel for Respondents, on instructions from Respondent No.1, refutes the statement made by the Petitioner and states that Petitioner

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earns close to Rs.40,000 to Rs.50,000/- per month from the sale of items in his shop. Petitioner resides with his mother and not in a rented accommodation. The address on the rent agreement and his permanent address is the same and an attempt is being made to misguide the Court. Learned counsel strenuously urges that time be given to place on record documentary evidence, which would show the falsity of Petitioner's stand and will reflect his income.

3. Let the affidavit be filed on behalf of the Respondents before the next date of hearing.

5. Petitioner and Respondent No.1 shall remain present in Court on the said date.
