ORDER

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1. The present writ petition has been filed seeking compensation in relation to death of Ms. Alisha, aged about 2^{1/2} years, who lost her life, due to negligence of respondent nos. 1 and 2, by falling in an open drain.
2. Issue notice. Notice is accepted by learned counsels for the respondents.
