1. The present application has been filed under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking interim suspension of sentence for a period of 60 days on the ground that the mother of the appellant passed away on 15.03.2026 and therefore, the appellant wants to attend the rituals/last rites of her mother.

2. The application is opposed by the learned Additional



Public Prosecutor for the respondent/ State who brings to my notice the report that has been filed by the Station House Officer concerned along with the statement of the appellant's brother.

3. In the said report, it is stated by the appellant's brother that in the event of the appellant being granted interim suspension of sentence, it would result in a tense situation in the household and therefore, he does not want the appellant to visit the house. The statement of the appellant's brother is also appended with the said report.

4. In such circumstances, allowing the application of the appellant/accused and allowing to go home would probably result in untoward incidents.

5. Hence, the application seeking interim suspension of sentence is dismissed.
