By way of the present application filed under Order VI Rule 17 read with section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure 1908, the plaintiff seeks amendment of the suit, submitting that during the pendency of the suit, the plaintiff/M/s Blue Heaven Cosmetics Private Limited alongwith another entity has been amalgamated into M/s. ESME Consumer Pvt. Ltd. in proceedings before the National Company Law Tribunal ('NCLT'), Mumbai. A copy of order dated 24.07.2024 passed by the NCLT, Mumbai in support of this submission has been appended to this application.

Mr. Sahil Gupta, learned counsel for the plaintiff submits, that they are in process of getting the necessary changes in the copyright certificate and trademark registration in relation to the intellectual property that is subject matter of the present suit; and that they undertake to file such documents on record in due course. Learned counsel submits that the plaintiff does not seek any other amendment to the plaint.



All defendants have been proceeded *ex-parte*.

Accordingly, in view of the amendment sought which is formal in nature and the fact that the defendants have been proceeded *ex-parte*, it is not considered necessary to issue notice on this application.

The application is allowed.

The amended memo of parties filed as well as the amended plaint filed alongwith the application are taken on record.
