1. Exemptions allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. The applications stand disposed of.

CS(OS) 605/2025 and I.A. 21794/2025

1. Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the plaintiff.
2. The plaint be registered as a suit. Issue summons. Mr.Vikram Aggarwal, learned counsel on behalf of the defendant nos.1 to 3 is present. Let a copy of the suit along with all documents be furnished to learned counsel who enters appearance on behalf of defendant nos.1 to 3. Receipt thereto be placed in the record.



3. Summons of the suit and notice of the accompanying application bearing I.A. 21794/2025 be issued to the remaining defendants by all permissible modes on filing of process fee. Affidavit of service be filed within two weeks.
4. Written statement shall be filed by defendant nos.1 to 3 within a period of thirty (30) days from today.
5. The summons shall indicate that written statements must be filed by the remaining defendants within thirty days from the date of receipt of summons. The defendant shall also file affidavits of admission/denial of the documents filed by the plaintiffs, failing which the written statements shall not be taken on record.
6. The plaintiff is at liberty to file replications thereto within thirty days after filing of the written statements. The replications shall be accompanied by affidavits of admission/denial in respect of the documents filed by the defendant, failing which the replications shall not be taken on record.
7. It is made clear that any unjustified denial of documents may lead to an order of costs against the concerned party.
8. Any party seeking inspection of documents may do so in accordance with the Delhi High Court (Original Side) Rules, 2018.
9. List before the learned Joint Registrar for completion of service and pleadings, marking of exhibits and admission/denial of documents on 26.11.2025.
10. Once the pleadings in application bearing I.A. 21794/2025 are complete, let the same be listed before the Court on the date to be fixed by the concerned Joint Registrar.
11. In the meantime, the parties are directed to maintain *status quo* as has



been agreed by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the plaintiff and defendant nos. 1 to 3.
