ORDER

1. Considering that the petitioner's application for grant of parole was submitted on 08.08.2024 and was decided by the impugned order, a considerable period has since elapsed. It has also been brought to the notice of the Court that, in the meantime, the petitioner has already been granted the benefit of parole.
2. In view of the above, the Court is of the opinion that, if any fresh ground survives, the petitioner shall be at liberty to submit a fresh application seeking furlough/parole, which shall be considered by the competent authority in accordance with law.
3. It is made clear that if such application is filed by the petitioner, the same shall be considered by the competent authority in accordance with law without any undue delay.



4. With these observations, the instant petition stands disposed of.
5. All rights and contentions of the parties are left open.
