(hereafter '**the Act**').

7. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the complaint was filed way back in the year 2018 and the cognizance was also taken on 23.03.2018.

8. He submits that the matter has not proceeded and is getting adjourned at the instance of the complainant. He submits that the pendency of the complaint is causing grave prejudice to the petitioners who were associated with the accused company at the relevant time.

9. He further submits that the complaint was filed alleging contravention of the provisions of the Act in regard to the activities being carried out by the accused company being M/s Rapid Buildwell Limited.

10. He further submits that the proceedings in regard to the accused company are also pending before the National Company Law Tribunal and the IRP has also been appointed.
