1. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions.

CRL.M.A. 5089/2026 (for preponement)

2. Disposed of as infructuous.

CRL.REV.P.(NI) 200/2025, CRL.M.(BAIL) 1863/2025 (for suspension of sentence) & CRL.M.A. 5741/2026 (for stay)

3. As on date, there is no suspension of sentence. Learned counsel for respondent/complainant submits that since the revisionist/convict had not been appearing before this Court or trial court, proceedings under Section 82 CrPC were commenced against him.

4. The revisionist is personally present in court today and submits that he wants to pay the entire fine amount of Rs. 3,00,000/- to the respondent/complainant by tomorrow morning, so he may be protected from



coercive process. Learned counsel for respondent/complainant does not object.

5. Accordingly, subject to the revisionist/convict paying the entire fine amount of Rs. 3,00,000/- to the respondent/complainant by 12:00 noon tomorrow (11.04.2026) before the learned trial court, no coercive process be executed against the revisionist/convict. However, it is made clear that in case by 12:00 noon tomorrow, the revisionist/convict does not pay the entire fine amount, there shall be no further protection and the learned trial court shall pass appropriate orders in accordance with law.
